

## CHAPTER 141

An Act to Amend Chapter 140 of the Acts of 1918, An  
Act to Amend the Law Respecting St.  
Mary's College, Halifax

(Passed the 10th day of April, A. D. 1952.)

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

1 Section 2 of Chapter 140 of the Acts of 1918, An Act to Amend the Law Respecting St. Mary's College, Halifax, is amended by striking out all the words after the word "Degree" in the thirteenth line thereof and substituting therefor the following:

St. Mary's  
University.

"and all the persons upon whom Saint Mary's University shall hereafter confer any Degree, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of Saint Mary's University."

2 Section 3 of said Chapter 140 is amended by striking out the words "or shall hereafter confer Degrees" in the eighth and ninth lines thereof and substituting therefor the words "or upon whom Saint Mary's University shall hereafter confer Degrees."

3 Sections 4, 5 and 7 of said Chapter 140 and Sections 8 and 9 of said Chapter 140, as those Sections are enacted by Chapter 126 of the Acts of 1949, are amended by striking out the word "College" wherever it appears in the said Sections and substituting therefor in each place where it so occurs the word "University," and by striking out the words "St. Mary's College, Halifax" and the words "St. Mary's College" wherever they occur in the said Sections and substituting therefor in each place where they so occur the words "Saint Mary's University."

4 Section 6 of said Chapter 140 is amended by striking out the words "of the College" in the fourteenth line thereof and the word "College" in the twenty-eighth line thereof.
